A Spanish Icon

On Monday, April 16, you will also notice a new addition in the "Classes & Workshops" section of the website: a Spanish icon! Several of our Spanish users had commented that it was difficult for them to tell which of our classes were actually being taught in Spanish without having to read through the class descriptions of all 51 classes--which was a valid point.

We put our heads together, and came up with a solution: a small, decorative icon, right behind the name of the course. If the class was being taught in Spanish, it would look like this:

The icon has been added to all of the current classes offered in Spanish, and if we receive positive feedback about our solution, we will continue to keep the icon in place in the future.

First Quarter Google Analytics Received

We have recently downloaded our first quarter Google Analytics for 2018 (January-March), and the numbers are good!!

For the Pollywog Website: we had 672 visitors to the site, 85% of which were new viewers. 2505 pages were viewed, which is an increase of 30% over last quarter. Most of our visitors were from the USA, but 108 were from Canada, and 17 from Poland. The Oregon cities that viewed our site most were Corvallis, Boardman (out by Hermiston), Albany, Portland, and Seattle. The most viewed page is our main page, and our "Classes & Workshops" page was second, followed by our "Resources" page. 33 people viewed the site in Spanish. The majority of our sources (how people found our site) came from samhealth.org followed by Facebook.

Our Facebook page also got good numbers last quarter. We have 52 fans and our daily reach is 2,288 (number of people who saw our posts). We posted 44 things to our Facebook page, and the most popular (most read) was the article, "How to Stay Calm when Baby

Won't stop Crying", which was liked by 58 people and shared 3 times.

Our Pollywog YouTube page had 75 audience views, 3 likes, and 2 shares. We currently have 5 videos posted to YouTube.
