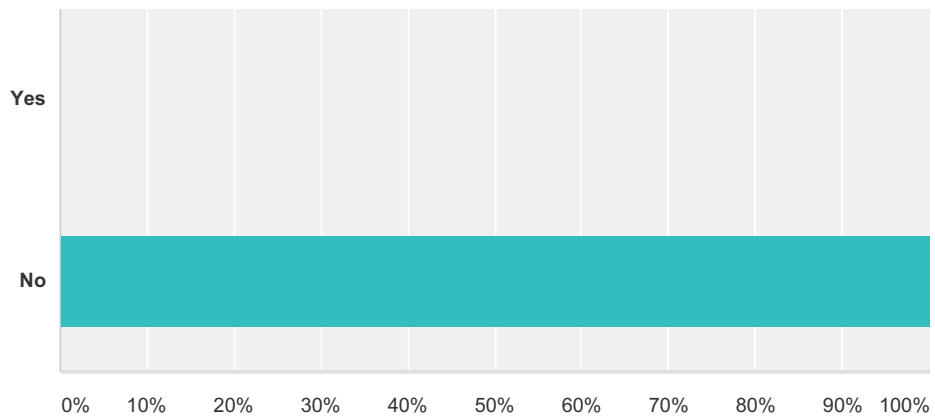

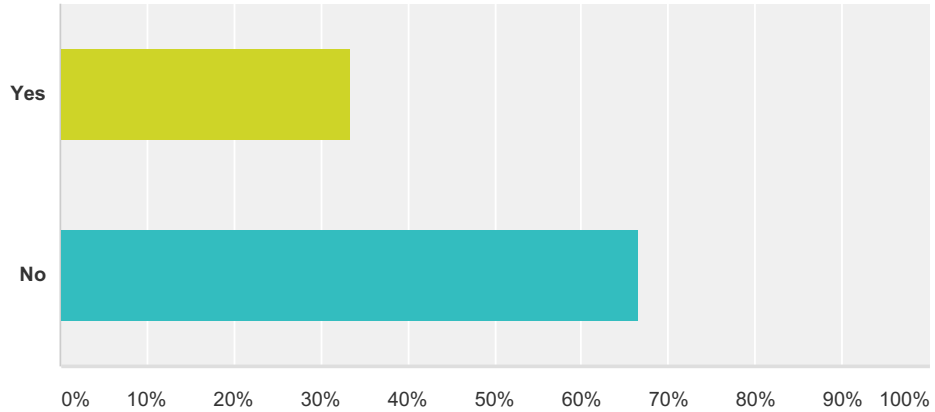

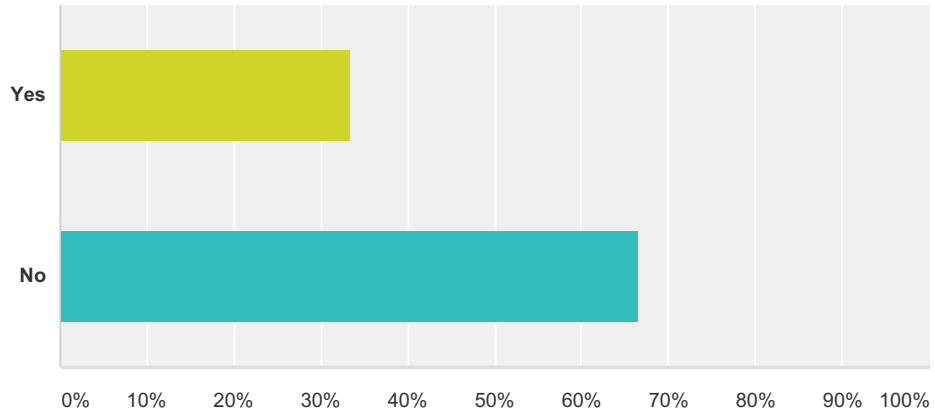

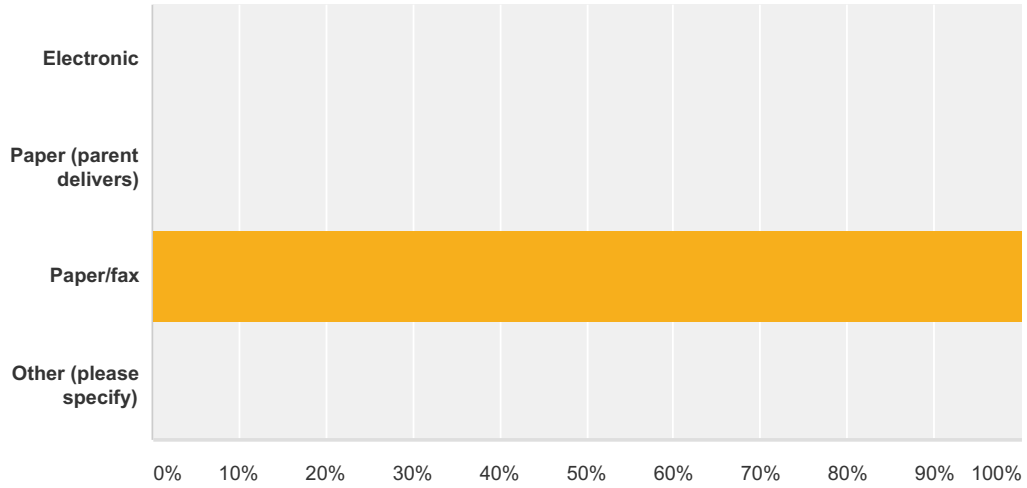

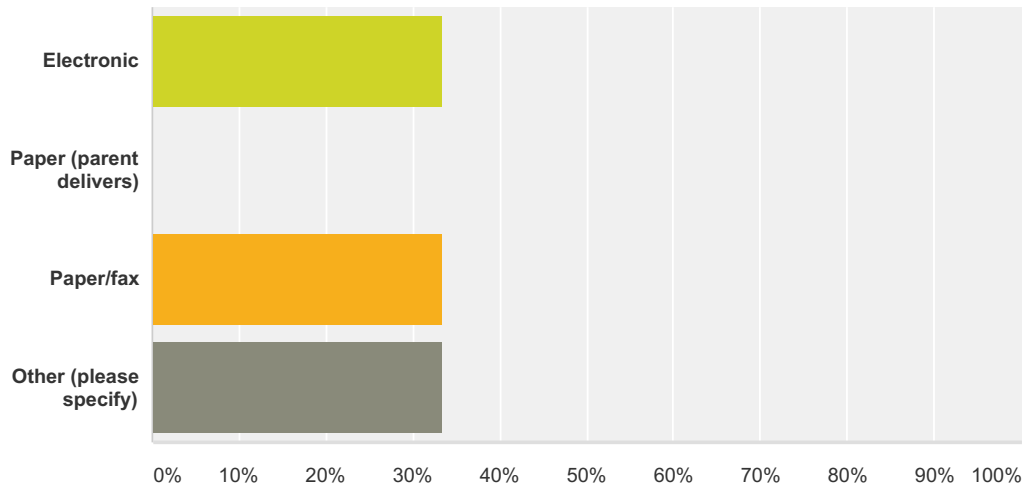

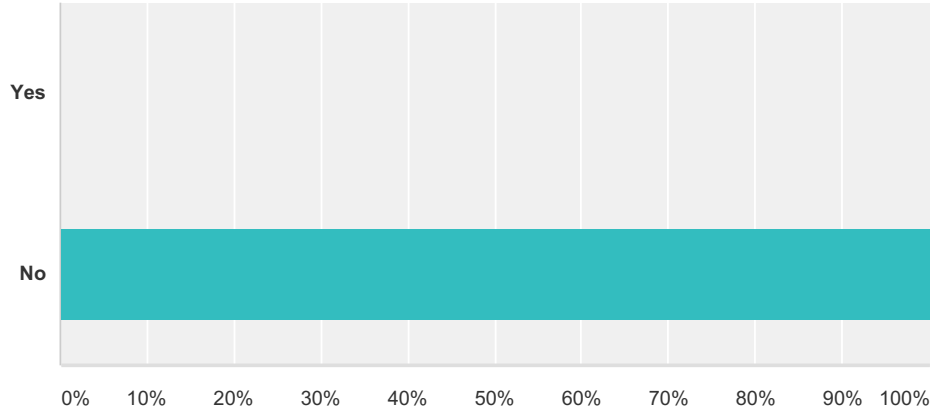

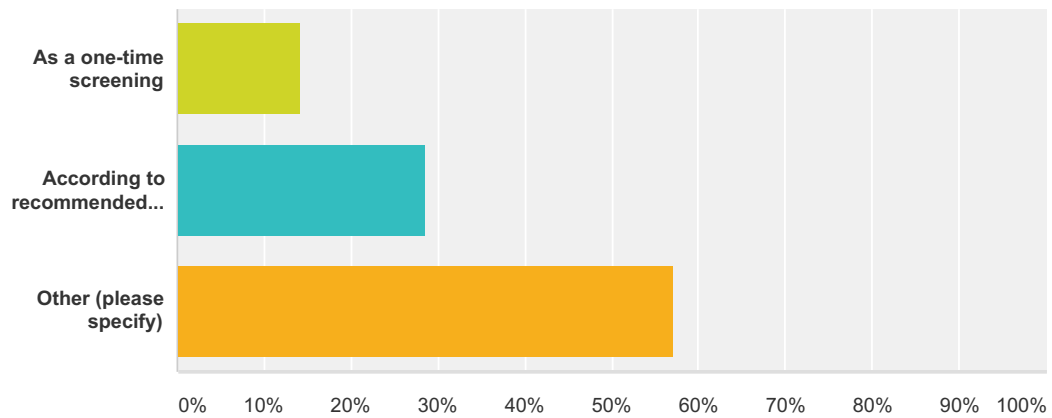

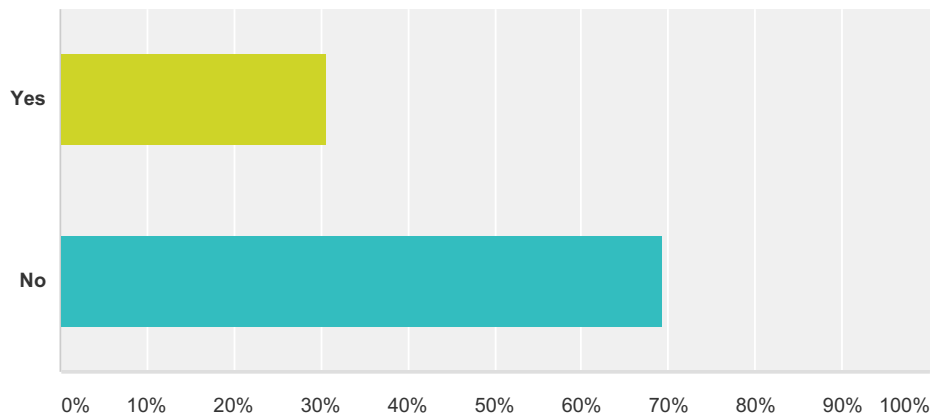

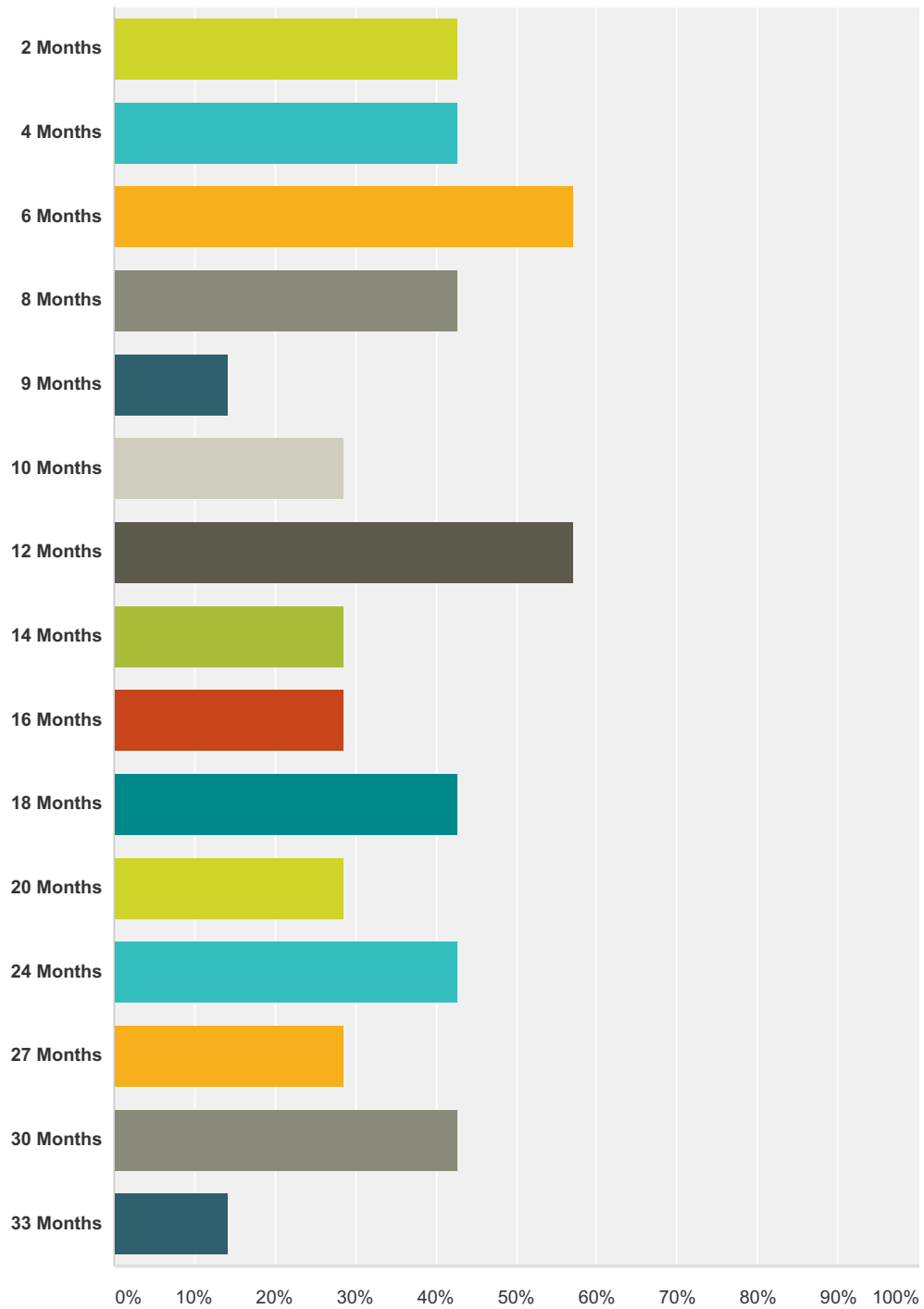

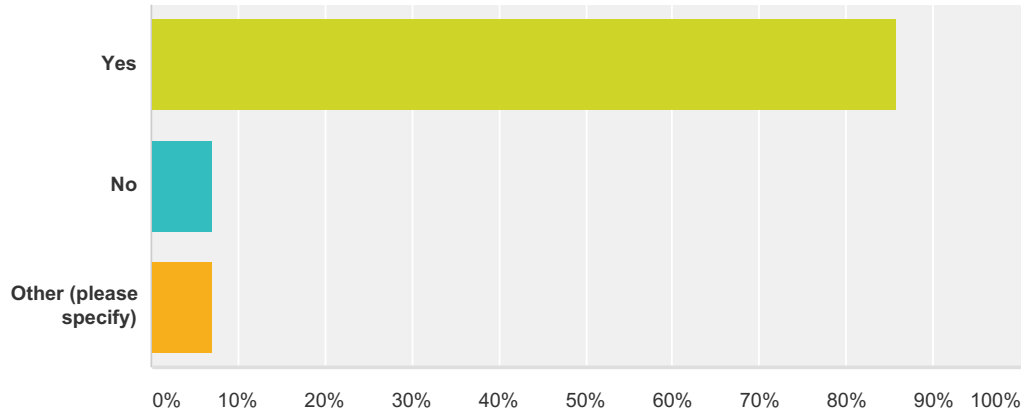

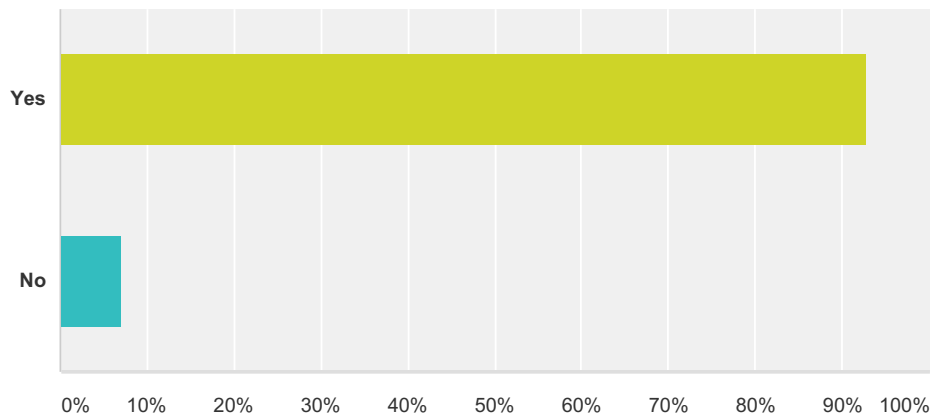

Q10 Do you review the developmental screening with the family?

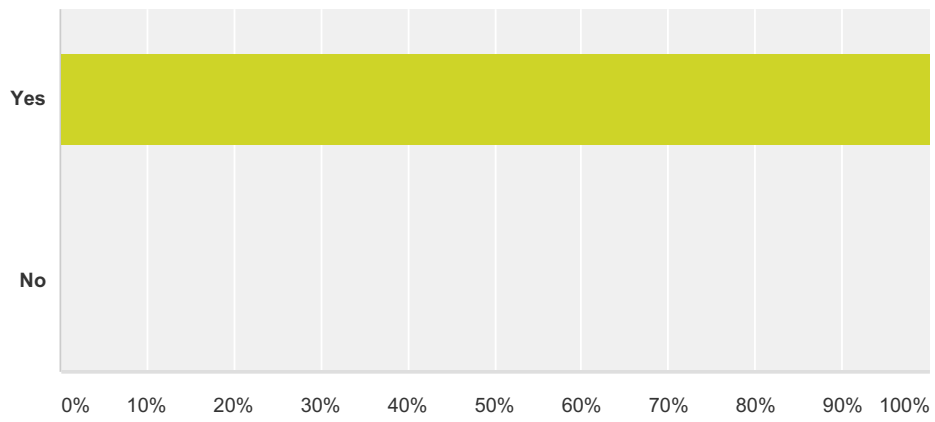

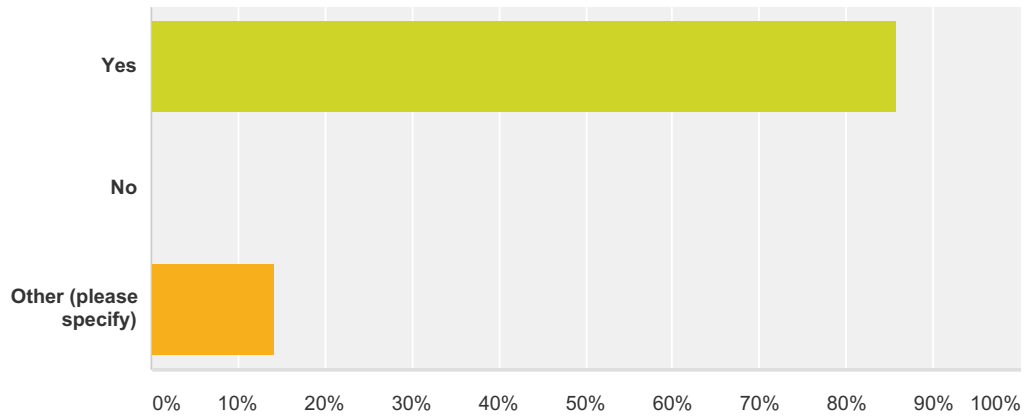

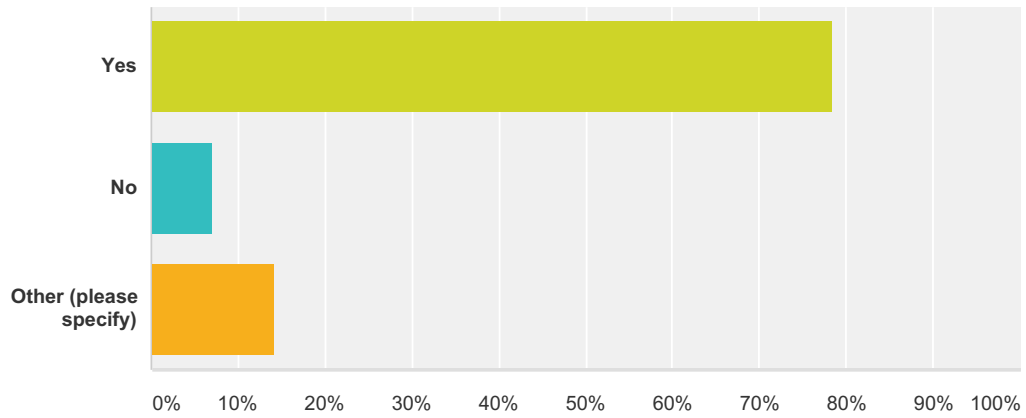

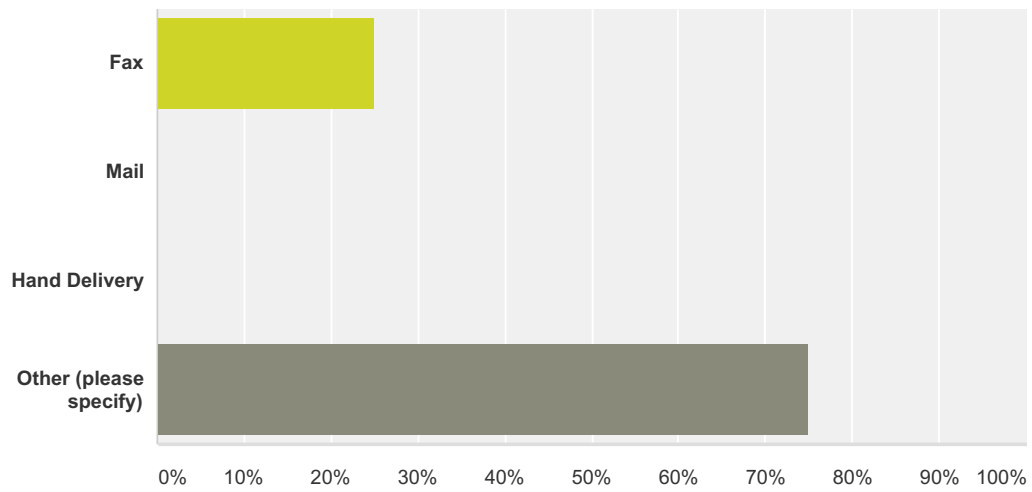

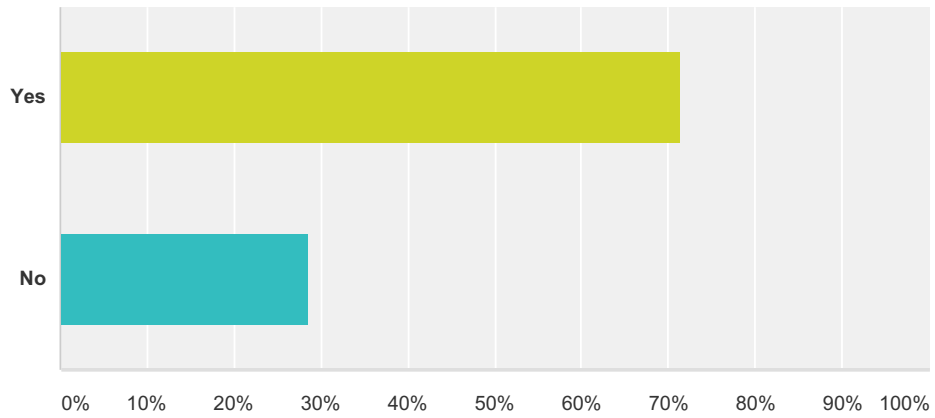

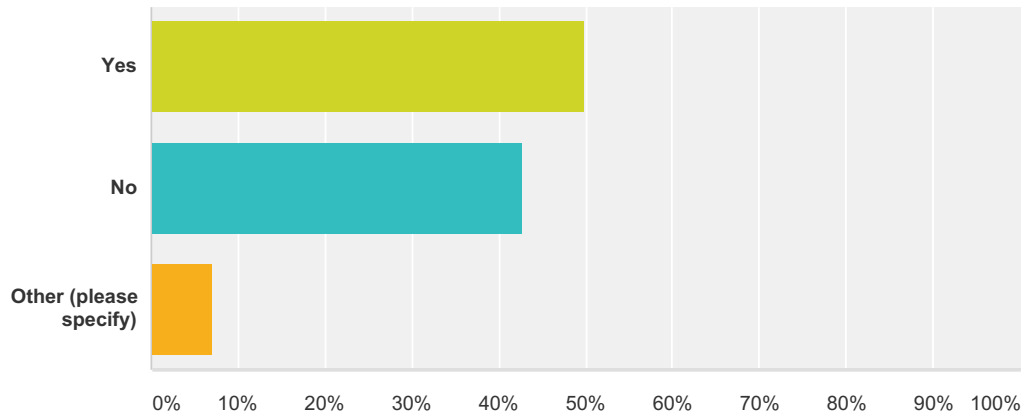
