(child care, preschool, recreation, parenting education, job training, transportation, affordable housing, health etc) Have you used any of those resources? What prevents you or your friends from accessing those resources?
- 4. You want to ensure **your child is ready for kindergarten/school.** Do you know what the schools expect your child to know for kindergarten? What resources are available in your area to help you prepare your child for kindergarten? Have you been able to connect with them? If not, what has prevented you from connecting?

- 5. When you have been involved helping other families or helping in the community/schools, what led you to become involved? Can you describe your experience? What made it possible for you to be supportive?
- 6. What are some of the challenges you face raising your children? What causes you the most stress or anxiety? What would be the most help to you?
- 7. Are there any other things not discussed today, that you would like the Linn Benton Lincoln Early Learning Hub to know?
