### Agenda topics

<b>DISCUSSION ITEM</b>	ASQ Training and Tracking Initiative
The Work Group is about to wrap up their START trainings for pediatricians in the three counties.	
Training a START trainer has been successful; Doctor Caroline Amador will be able to continue offering START trainings.	
Technical assistance is necessary to ensure that clinics implement the procedures successfully. However, only two clinics signed up for TA with this grant.	
Kelsey Branca's PowerPoint on the START trainings (IHN Transformation Grant) is on basecamp.	
Madeleine agrees to connect with Kristi from DHS about her response regarding ASQ starter kits.	
Samaritan's system tells providers when the ASQ is due. Miranda Miller is curious if there is a way for EPIC to receive information from RHIC when an ASQ is completed so the provider receives credit.	
Rebecca explains that the Work Group is currently negotiating this process.	
Samaritan's primary care clinics in Corvallis have monthly provider meetings, back-office meetings, and general membership meetings.

<u>Review/Revise Draft Decision Tree</u>	
The Work Group revises which community resources are available in each county.	
Miranda sent this document to Mid-Valley Children's Clinic and is awaiting response.	
Lynn agrees to contact Kim Whitley to inquire what terminology means in Group A and B.	
Miranda agrees to write up terminology and send to Lynn in December.	
Rich recommends presenting this Decision Tree document to providers at a provider meeting.	
The Work Group decides to add Risk/Head Categories under Resources Section.
