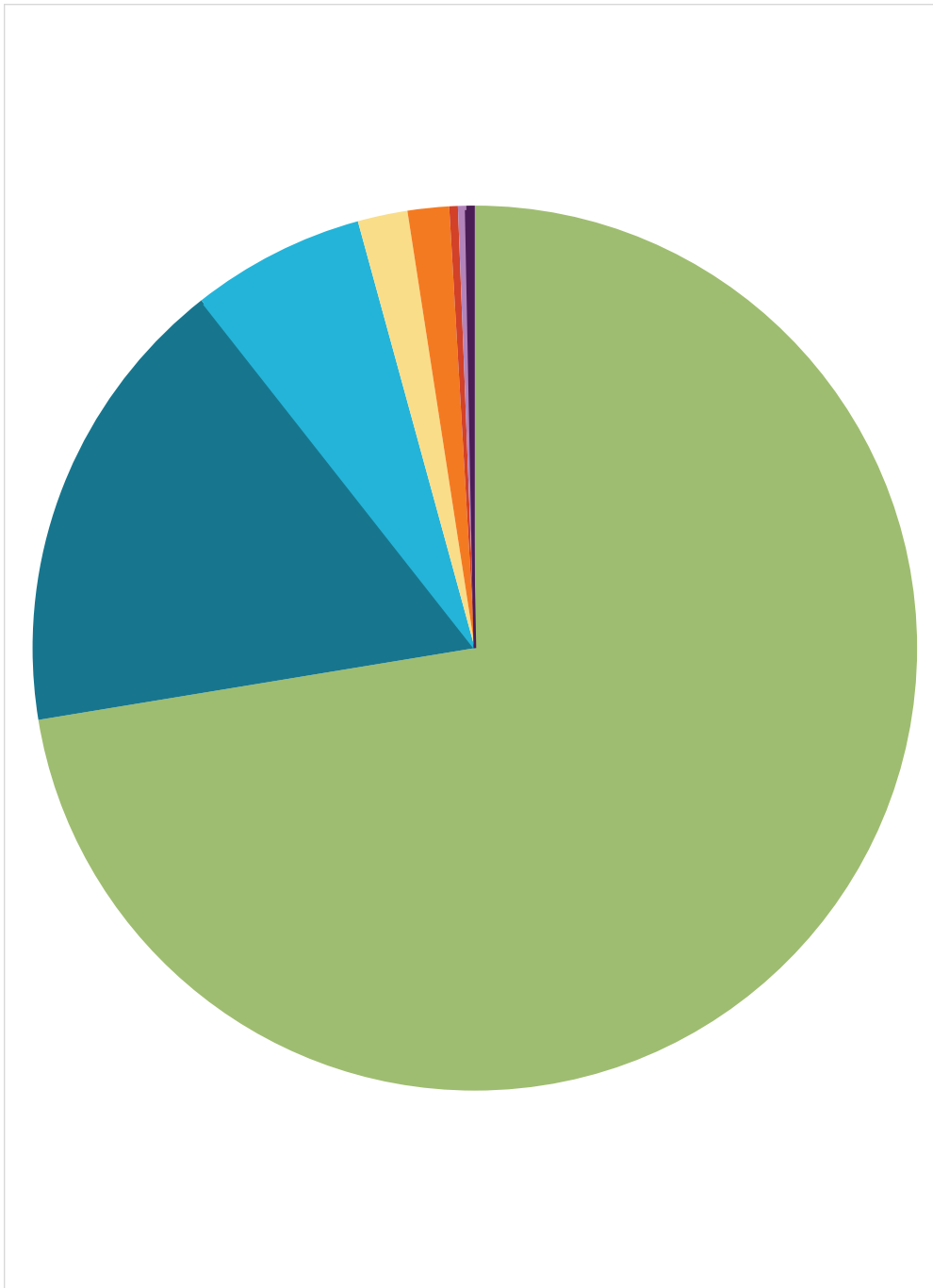

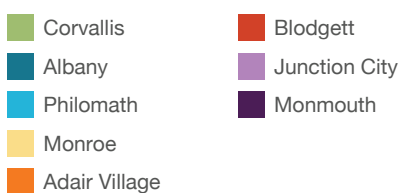

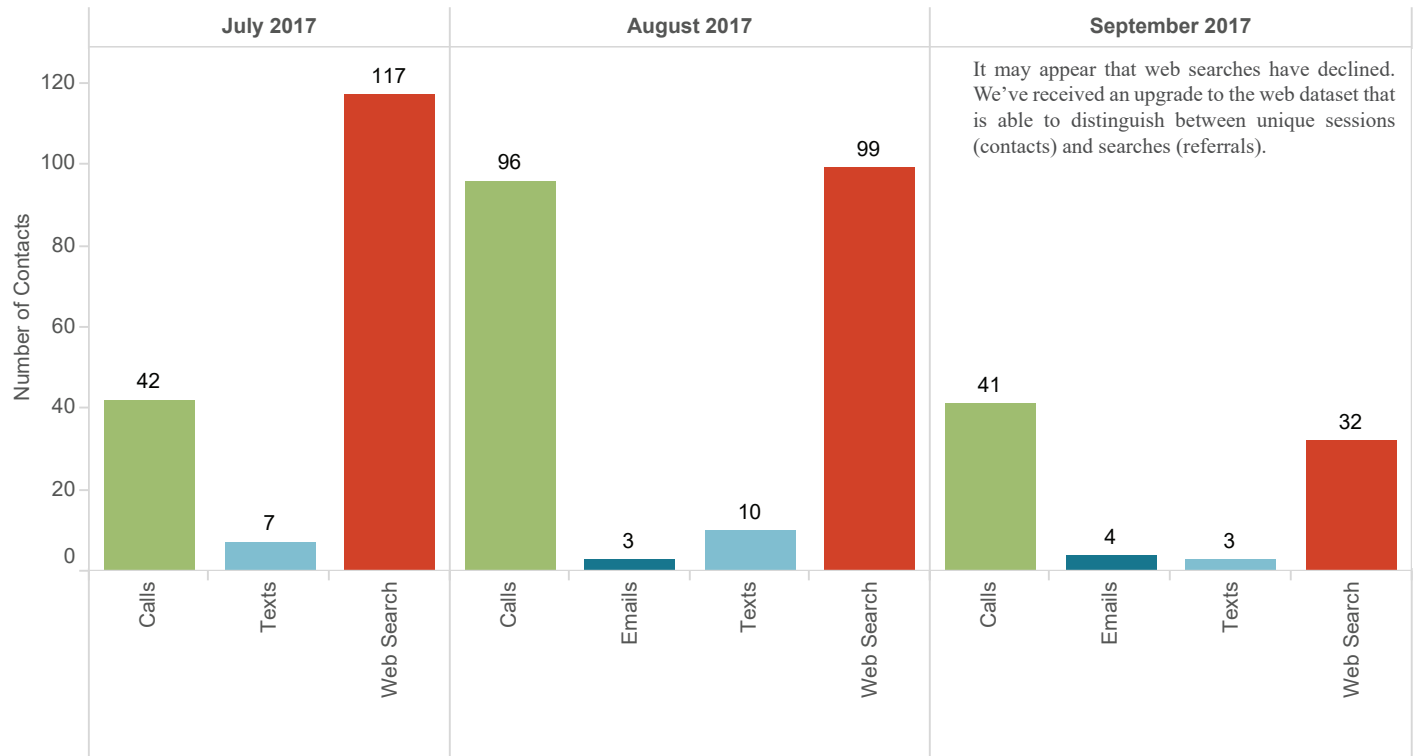

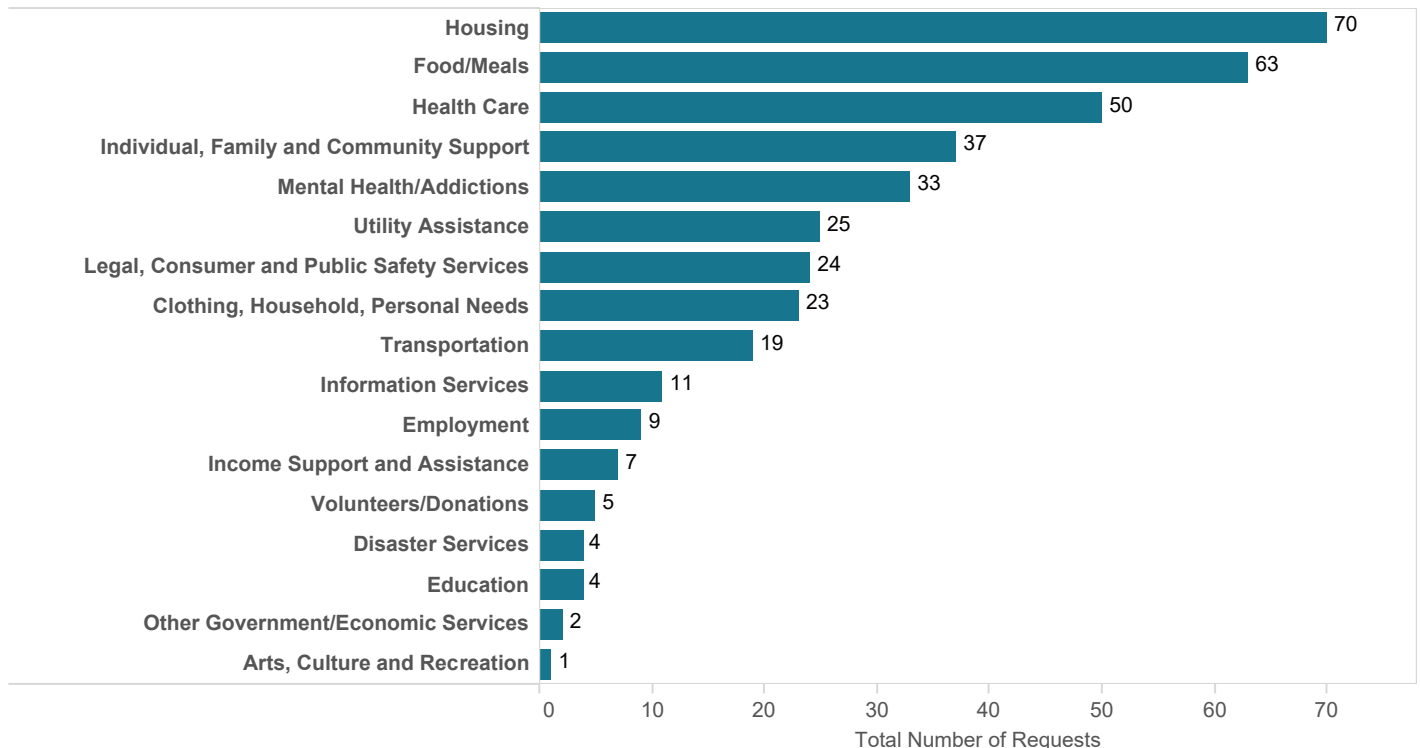

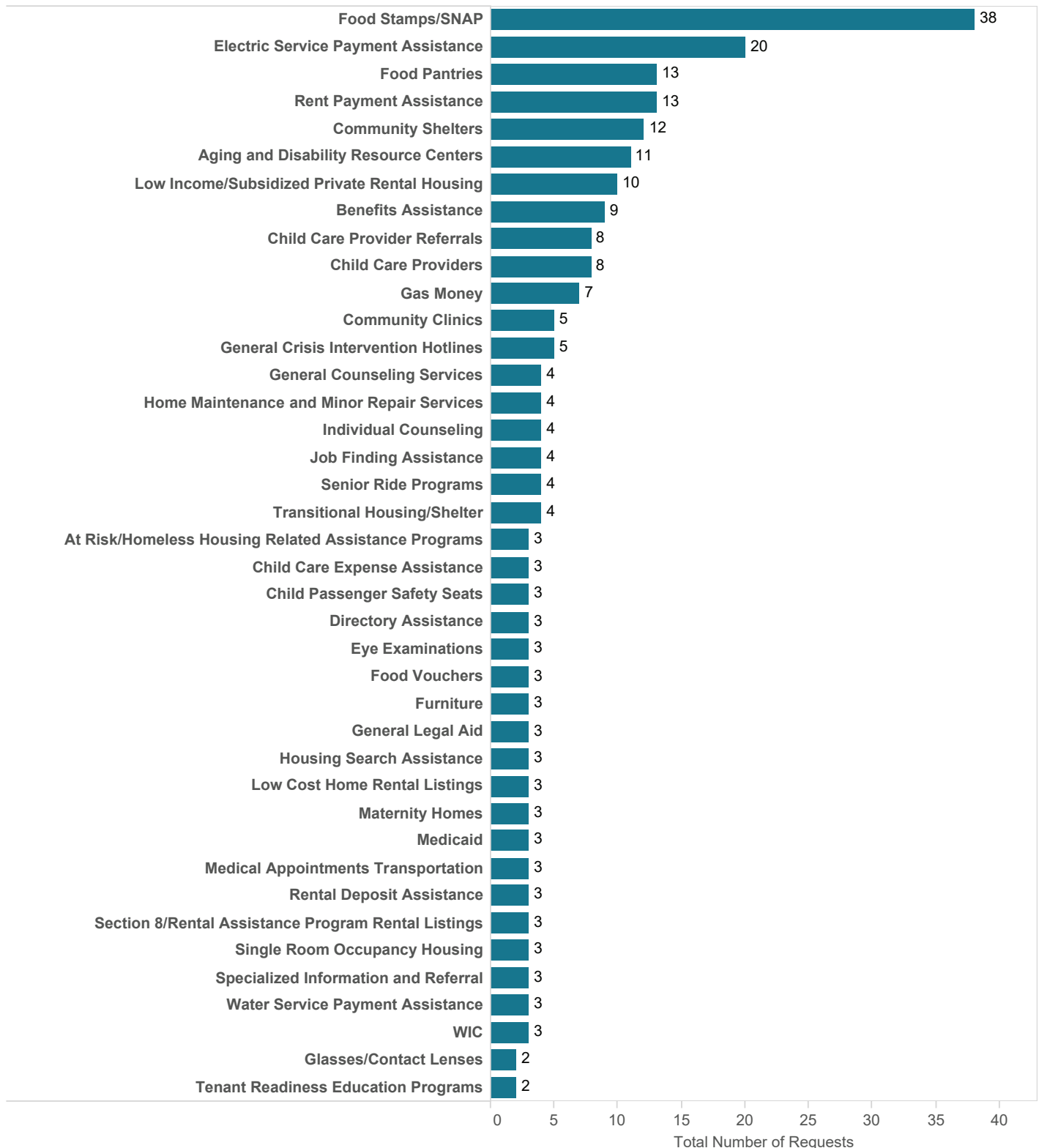
Number of contacts, grouped by month and contact type

Number of services with three or more requests across all contact types

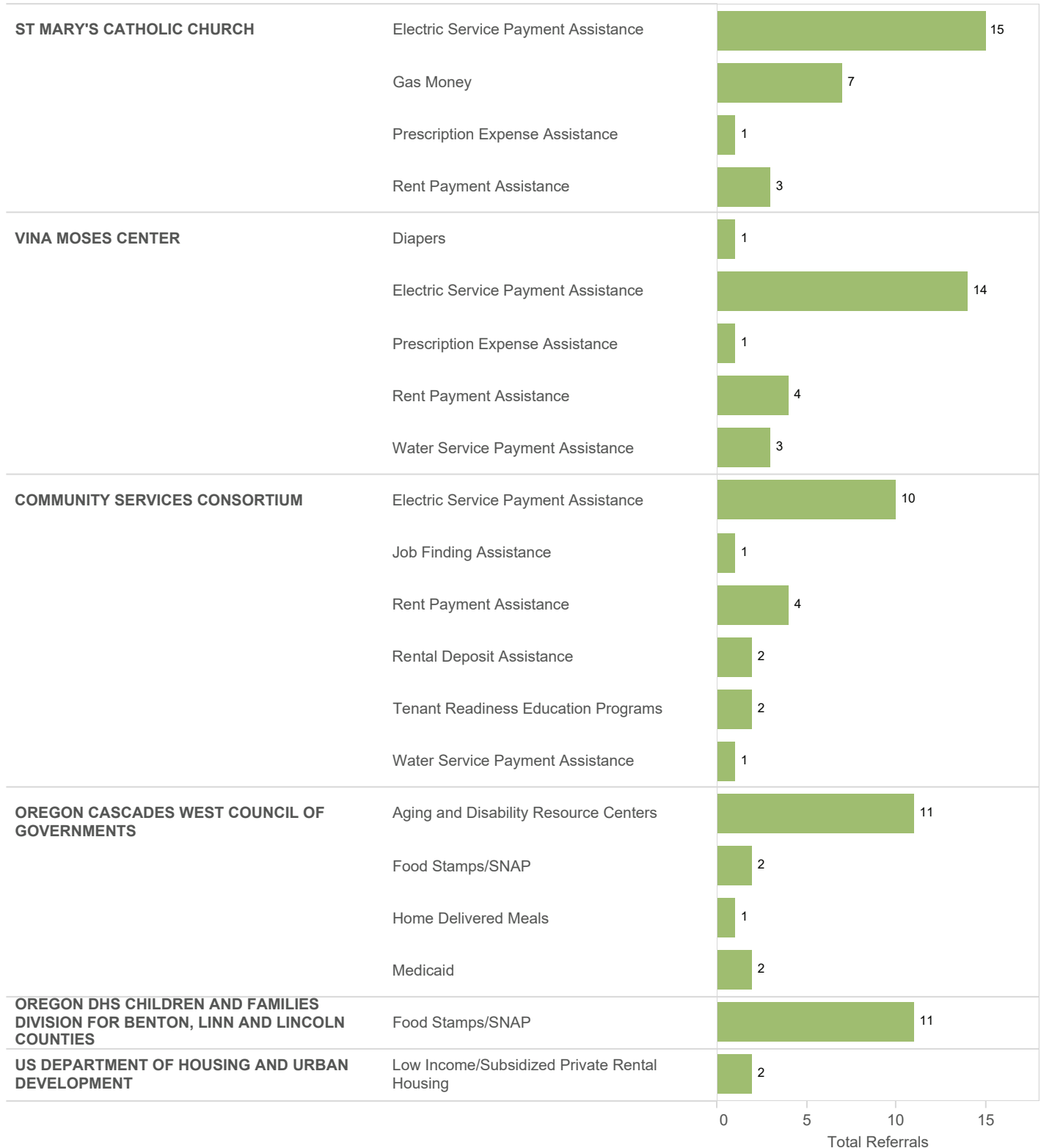

Top 5 agencies referred to across all contact types



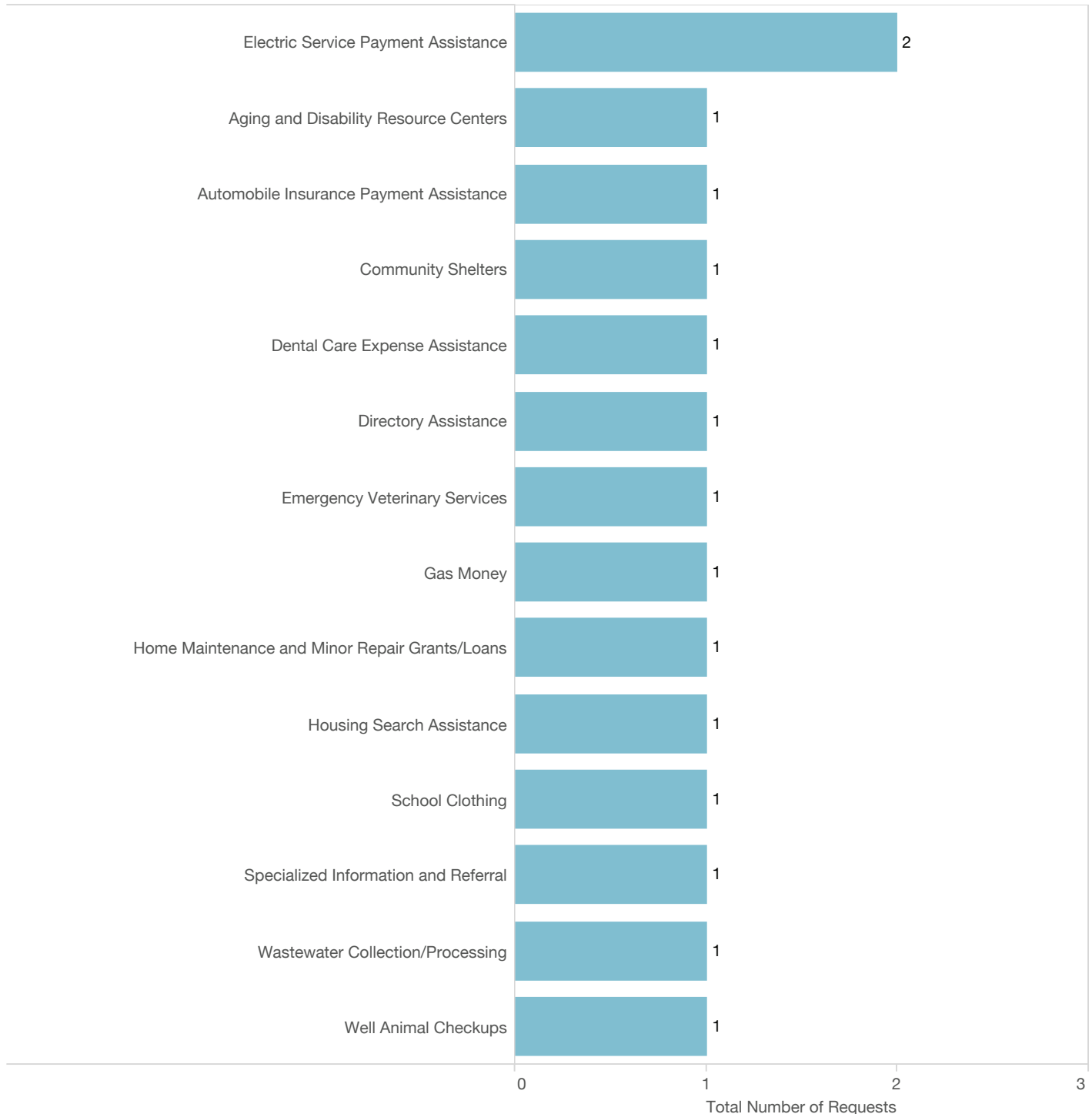

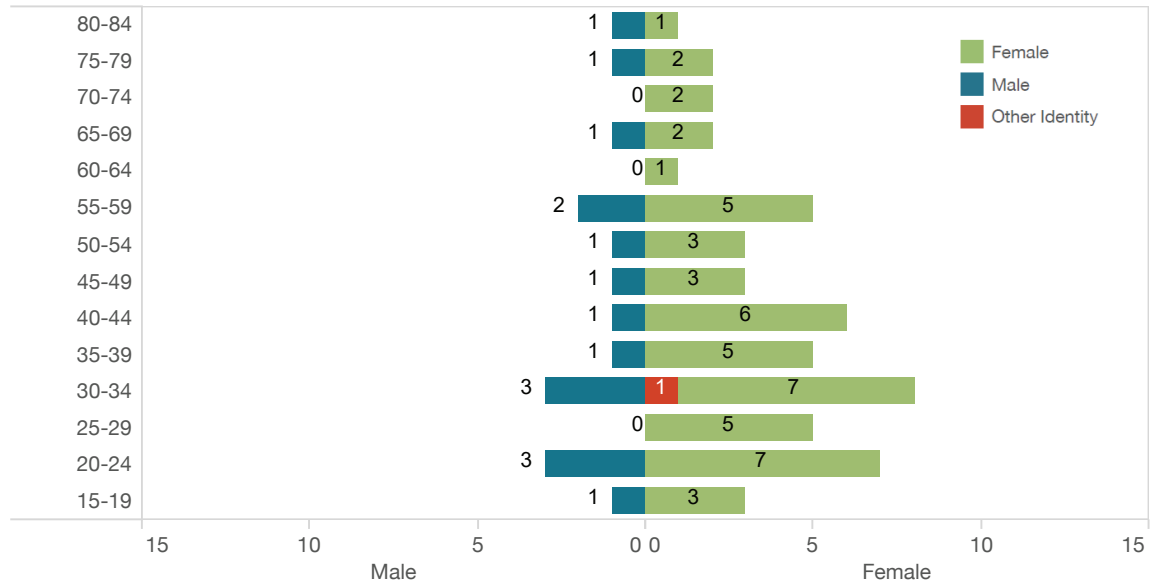

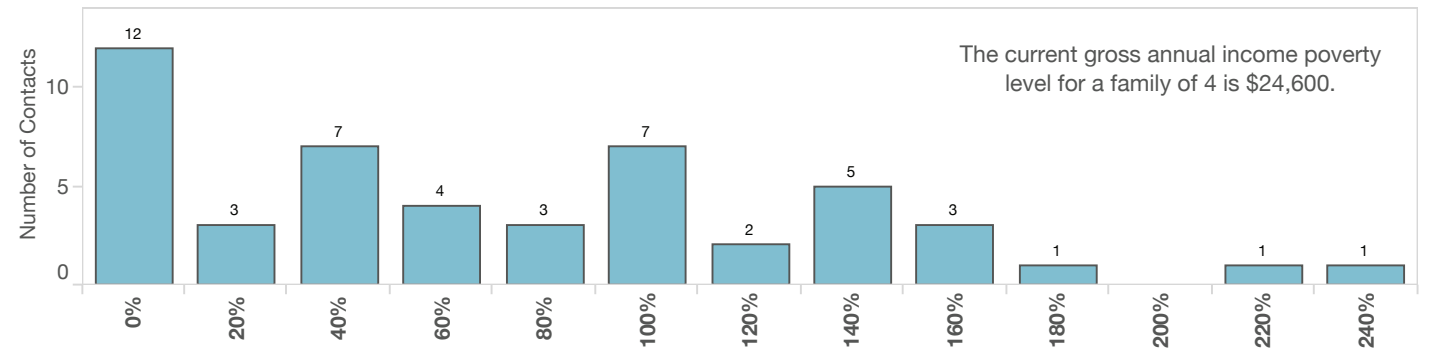

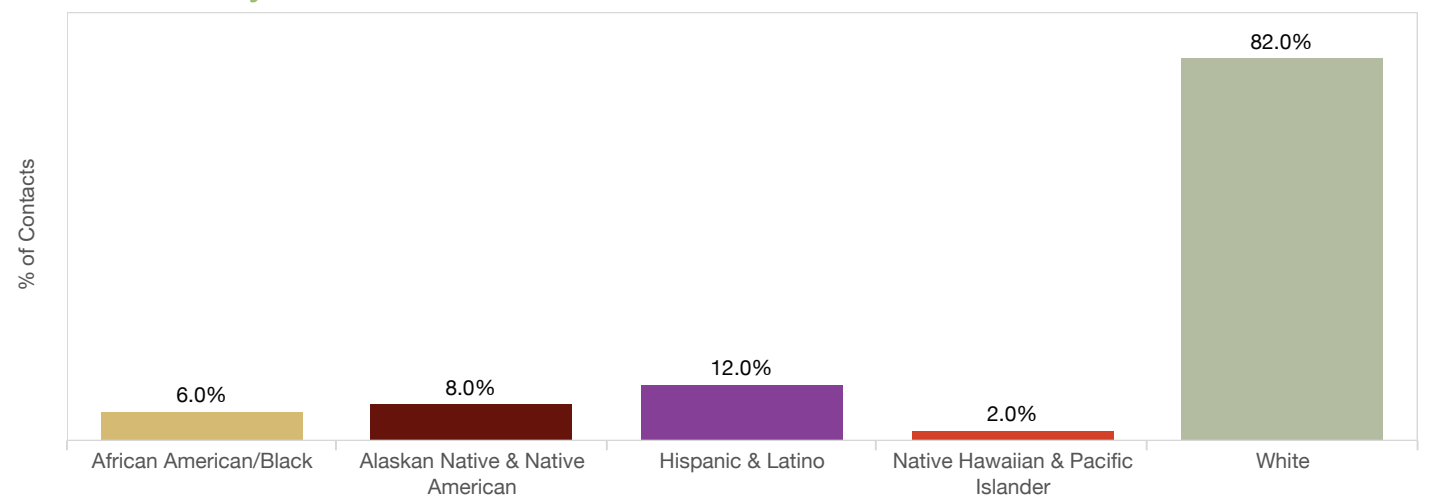
Age and gender

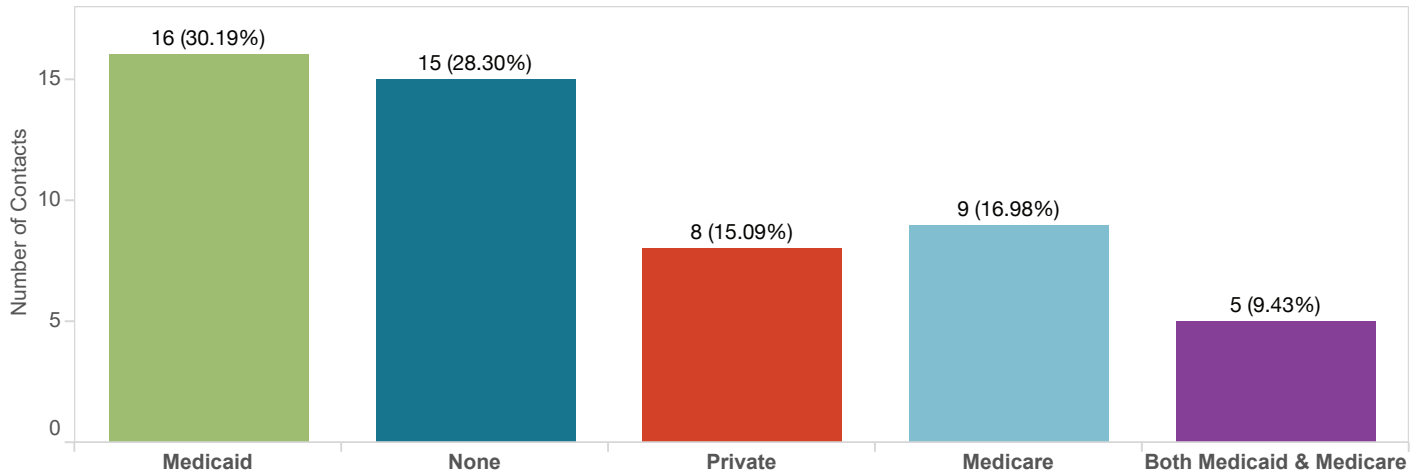

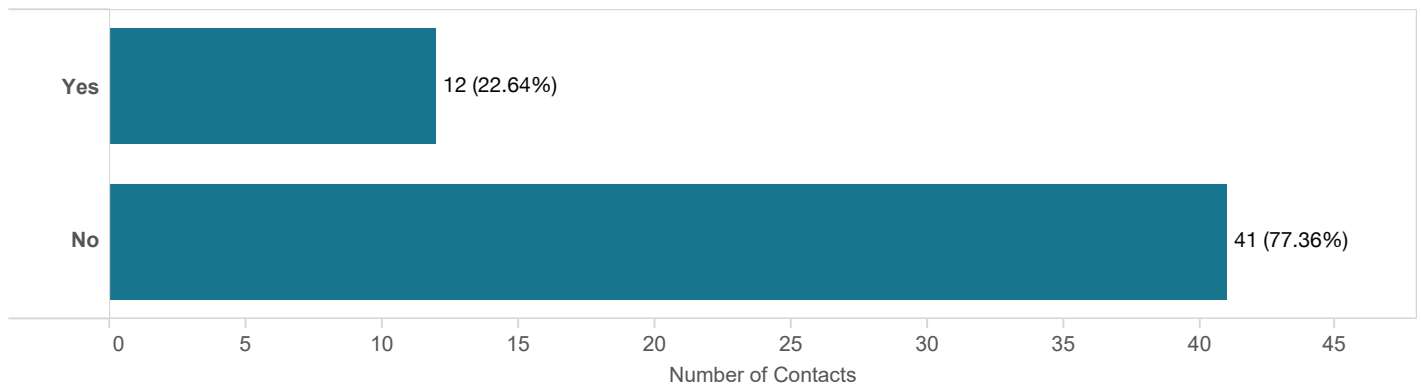

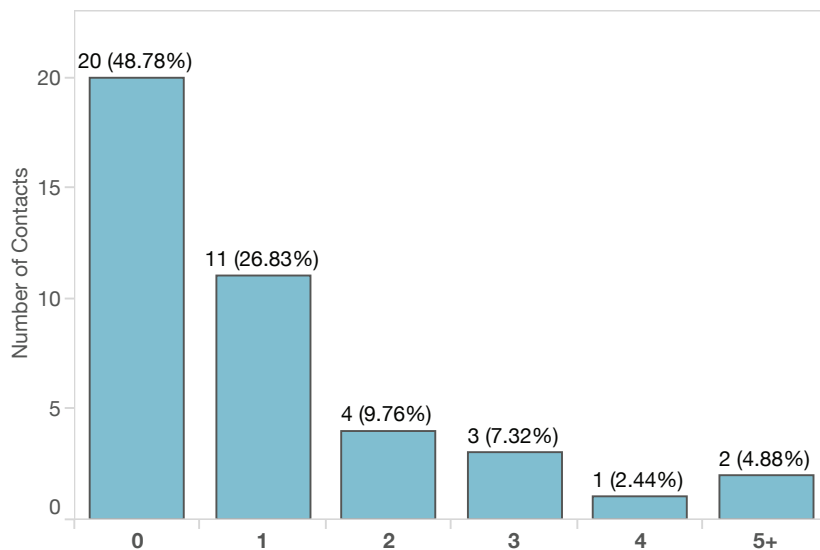
Health insurance status
