Follow-Up Based on Total Score Across Domains:

ASQ Domain Scores

Group A: "Priority Referral" 2 or More in the Black

Step 1: Developmental Promotion Provided at Visit:

- ASQ Learning Activities for specific domains identified at risk
- Information on Vroom

Step 2: Refer To: Early Intervention for an evaluation (use Universal Referral Form)

Step 3: Consider:

- Referral to Pediatric Specialist (see referral list from Miranda Miller)
- Referral to supports available through 211 and/or Pollywog. See below: Additional Resources to Consider.
- Supplementing Medical and Therapy Services

Group B: "At Risk" 1 in Black OR 2 or More in Grey and could benefit from EI

Step 1: Developmental Promotion Provided at Visit:

Step 2: Consider:

- Referral to Early Intervention for an evaluation (use Universal Referral Form to determine eligibility, get FERPA signed, indicate "Summary Evaluation Form" to receive Summary of Services)

- Supplementing Medical and Therapy Services

Group C: "Monitoring" 2 or more Grey or 1 in Black but not ready for Referral to EI

Step 1: Developmental Promotion Provided at Visit:

Step 2: Re-Screen in 3-6 months; set up a follow-up if child does not have a visit
