

Stewards of Children is a 2.5-3 hour training that implements video modules and facilitator-led interactive discussions. It is currently offered for free thanks to a grant from the Ford Family Foundation. Trainings can be scheduled at any time of day, any day of the week, at any location in Benton or Linn County, and are available in both English and Spanish.

Some professionals, like registered nurses, child care providers, licensed social workers and counselors, and EMS providers, can receive 2 contact hours of continuing education from this training. Further, each individual educational district, school district, and school has the ability to approve CEU/PDU qualification for certified teachers and classified staff who attend this training.
