Last week we hand delivered a large number of flyers for the event around Sweet Home and Lebanon, and then we emailed flyers to other local partners and community members.

### What's Happening

- ✓ The next Pollywog Partner Meeting has been scheduled for Thursday, August 13, 2018, from 9-10:30am, in LM-130 at the Luckiamute Center on the LBCC campus. A calendar invitation will be sent out soon to the listserv. We will be discussing: how the referral process is going, the final version of the HIPAA/FERPA PowToon, the status of the ASQ/RHIC Collaboration Pilot, and a review of the expansion plans into the Lebanon community. Please plan on joining us.
- ✓ Currently there are 452 individuals in the Pollywog database, 28 prenatal, parenting education, and children's activities available, and 40 eReferrals have been made.



The meeting will begin promptly at 2:00pm, and Laurie Barajas will be there to introduce Pollywog. We will also be serving light snacks and beverages.
