DISCUSSION ITEM	Review of Regional Health Collaborative Meeting by Lynn Hall
<p><u>House Bill 2267</u>: Multiple agencies completed Community Health Assessments without coordination or sharing processes. This bill, however, directs agencies to collectively complete these CHAs.</p> <p><u>Agencies Involved – CHA Requirements</u>: LeAnne provided a handout with key requirements for public health and CCOs.</p> <p><u>Regional Crosswalk of CHIPS in Our Region</u>: The group discusses the Regional Crosswalk handout, which provides information on the alignment of community health improvement plans in our region. Each county completed their own CHA and will create a collaborative CHIP. This will begin in January 2020.</p>

<p><u>Review of Email from Julie Manning</u>: “Related to early childhood, note that the ASQ/developmental screening is going away and a new metric regarding well-child exams is being established. There is also a change in the dental metric (moving away from sealants and onto a preventative screening). The immunization metric continues, as does timely post-partum care.”</p> <p><u>Review Metrics & Scoring Committee</u>: The group highlights metrics that the Health Care Integration work group can focus on.</p> <p>Next Steps:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow up on Boost Oregon/Samaritan trainings and IHN-CCO expectations. • Pollywog can help coordinate resources to get parents into well-child checks and developmental milestones • Educate parents about well-child checks • Do we want to focus on multiple metrics at once or focus on one and go in-depth? • Consider utilizing the Pollywog parent newsletter, blog, and even Jumpstart Read for the Record. • Shirley recommends the Boost Oregon training for parents in Happy Valley, Oregon. • Can OHA reexamine their immunization schedules to accommodate for families on the delayed 	

immunization schedule?
