<b>DISCUSSION ITEM</b>	Updated Powtoons
<p>Katy created two Powtoons: one that describes ACEs and one that presents resources for minimizing ACEs. Kelly Locey at Benton County Health Department reviewed and approved Katy's Powtoons after making a few minor suggestions.</p>	
<p>Group Discussion:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• These Powtoons are meant for partners but not parents. The model of the Early Learning Hub and committees is to share information.</li> <li>• Information on these Powtoons and links will be included in the January director report, after Kristi's approval.</li> <li>• The numbers inside the colored bubbles are unclear. If they refer to Raise Up Oregon objectives, we need clarification.</li> <li>• To provide context for the resources Powtoon (part 2), include the two slides describing ACEs. This change will transform this Powtoon into a stand-alone video.</li> <li>• The "prevention" slide is unclear. The shape implies that the four sentences lead to "ensure a strong start for children." Consider a different flow/graphic.</li> <li>• Change "What can Oregon do..." to "What can Oregon's framework do..."</li> <li>• Include a call to action slide that replaces the resources slide. Resources could be included in the description box on YouTube. Consider "for more information, visit" a resource, and "to get involved, visit" local resources.</li> <li>• Consider including "Paper Tigers" as a resource. Where best should this resource live?</li> <li>• Consider remaking CDC resources for local information.</li> <li>• Children in our region experience a number of experience that impact short and long-term health. These are described by ACEs. To learn how we are approaching ACEs, please view these Powtoons and additional resources.</li> <li>• Powtoons are one leg of a three-legged stool regarding information distribution. Consider showing to a PTO/PTA/committees with a two-pager informational handout and a toolkit for brainstorming next steps.</li> </ul>	
<p>Next Steps:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Confirm with Kristi that we can publish the Powtoons to include in the director report scheduled to send out December 19, 2019.</li> <li>• Confirm next steps with Early Childhood Coordination Council and P-3 Alignment work groups.</li> </ul>	

<b>DISCUSSION ITEM</b>	Review Hub Input to Access to Health Services Survey (Transformation Committee)
