2. Boost Oregon Workshop:
 - ✓ Last month we talked about the Oregon Pediatric Society's warning that vaccinations and well-baby visits were way down in Oregon.
 - ✓ We got an email from Boost Oregon requesting that we publicize their upcoming workshop
 - ✓ This is their second virtual vaccine workshop for parents
 - ✓ Tuesday, June 16, 7:00pm
 - ✓ Led by mom and certified physician's assistant, Rebecca Reveal
 - ✓ Attendees must register, and the workshop is limited to 12
3. Oregon Health Authority Update:
 - ✓ Latino population has a much higher COVID rate
 - ✓ Messaging is not working, or they don't understand the messaging
 - ✓ OHA coming out with 12 new specific messages for 12 minority populations to try to help
 - ✓ The first weekend in May, when the state started to open up, there was a big outbreak in Bend because of family gatherings
 - ✓ Created new Resource List
4. Benton County Health Department Update:
 - ✓ "County Tracers" are working tirelessly to trace the path of the COVID virus in our communities, but they are having some issues:
 - ✓ 2-3 hour phone call to figure out the last two weeks of a person's life – not well received
 - ✓ People are lying to the County Tracers because they don't want to admit where they were or what they were doing
 - ✓ People are hanging up on the County Tracer's, or just won't answer their phones
 - ✓ Benton County asking for our help, when we speak to our immigrant populations to explain what we are trying to do and why we need their help

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5. IHN-CCO Update:
 - ✓ Making rent payments for affected families
 - ✓ Renting blocks of hotel rooms for medically fragile homeless individuals
 - ✓ Large uptick in individuals signing up for the OHP – 2500 in Benton County alone
 - ✓ DST preparing to hear proposals for their grant funds
 - ✓ New category, “Promising Practices” which will renew funding for those spreading past projects that were successful

 - ✓ Virtual Webinar from Zero to Three
 - ✓ “Telling the story of America’s babies. Where do Oregon’s babies stand?” Very important discussion of how the current pandemic has exposed and exacerbated the existing disparities and structural barriers that affect the well-being of young children and their families
