 - Samaritan employees lost 12 homes to wildfires in Lincoln City
 - Samaritan Foundation is offering support
 - IHN needs input on SHARE (Supporting Health for All through Reinvestment) Initiative
 - 2018 Legislature requires CCOs to reinvest a portion of profits in Social Determinate of Health issues
 - 2019 Legislature readjusted dollar amounts to invest
 - IHN-CCO will be investing about \$2m in 2020
 - Social Determinants of Health Committee will be controlling the process
