

## Pollywog Staff Changes and Family Connects

Most people are aware that the State Legislature mandated a universal nurse home visiting program in Oregon during the 2019 Legislative session. The State chose “Family Connects” as the program that would deliver those home visiting services, and our region--Linn, Benton and Lincoln Counties--were chosen as early adopters of the new program.

The concept behind Family Connects is that before the family leaves the hospital after having a new baby, they are contacted by either a Family Connects representative or by the nurses on the maternity ward about signing up for a home visit, usually within the first three weeks after birth. (Please note that adopted and foster children are also included in the State’s vision

of the program.) Pollywog staff will also talk to prenatal families, as will the Maternity Care Coordinators, the Community Doula, and the Healthy Families home visitors. Ideally, all of these programs will be working together to ensure that every new Oregonian gets a visit from a nurse in their home.



Initially the Family Connects program wanted the Early Adopters to use their database and their method of identifying social service agencies to refer families to. Because Pollywog is already established in our region--and doing basically the same work--it was decided that Pollywog would be the official Information & Referral provider for Family Connects. The Oregon Health Authority is assisting that move by providing funding for a “Community Alignment Specialist”(CAS) to work within Pollywog to provide additional resource identification. In December we received nine applications for the CAS position, and we are pleased to announce that Connie Adams has been hired to fill the role. With her background in home visiting, her extensive knowledge of Pollywog and it's systems, and her contacts within the community, we foresee great strides being made with her help!

### What's Happening

- ✓ The next Pollywog Partner Meeting is scheduled for Thursday, February 11, from 9-10:30am. This will be a remote meeting, using the Zoom platform. Meeting log-in information will be available on the Early Learning Hub website, and we will also be sending out a Google invitation.
- ✓ Currently there are 1,479 individuals in the Pollywog database, as well as 9 prenatal and 37 parenting education classes, 4 courses taught in Spanish, and 146 referrals have been sent through Pollywog. Winter term classes began on January 4, but in a few weeks the Spring Term classes will be publicized and you can begin planning your term!
