

Why was this dashboard created?

This dashboard was created to convert the data that the Early Learning Hub regularly uses into a more interactive, readily-accessible format. Most importantly, we want this data to be available to our partners in order for them to be able to answer questions relevant to their work. We also want to enable and encourage community leaders and partners to allocate resources to focus populations in Linn, Benton and Lincoln County communities.

What is this dashboard being used for?

Data Dashboard User Guidance

What types of questions can I answer using this dashboard?

This tool focuses primarily on Kindergarten Assessment (KA) scores, though you can also evaluate 3rd Grade Math and English Language Arts scores, data on absenteeism, and more. For most measures, this dashboard allows you to evaluate trends down to the individual school-level.

In this dashboard you can:

- 1) Compare KA scores across schools, districts, and counties.
- 2) Compare KA scores across demographic sub-groups.
- 3) Compare 3rd Grade Math and ELA Scores across schools, districts, and counties.
- 4) Look at trends and changes in scores over time.

Tips for using this dashboard:

In the top left corner of each data tab, you can find an explanation of the features available on the tab, along with a description of the main variables being analyzed. Though some tabs have slightly different features, all tabs give you the option to select, or "slice", the data in different ways by clicking on the box options. On most tabs, you also have the option to compare multiple selections at once by selecting multiple boxes.

Here are some other general tips:

- -To return to the navigation page, click on the *compass icon* in the top right of any page.
- -Return to this guidance page at any point by clicking the *question mark icon*.
- -Follow the link to the Regional Data Book by clicking the *information icon* on any page.
- -Alternatively, go from tab to tab using the drop-down menu in the lower left of your screen.
- -Hover over the data bars and dots in the plots to gain more information.
- -You can also click the data bars and points to interact with other graphs.

Educator observes and records child's interactions with other children and classroom materials using the Child Behavior Rating Scale (CBRS). A final Approaches to Learning (Total) score between 1 and 5 is given based on the average score of 15 total questions. Assessment focuses on a child's approaches to learning, self-regulatory skills, and interpersonal skills. CBRS is strongly predictive ofreading and math achievement in elementary grades and has been validated in a wide range of cultural contexts.












KA Approaches to Learning Total Scores (1-5) by School and District






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Average Number of Letter Sounds Recognized (0-26) by Year and County





Average Number of English Uppercase and Lowercase Letter Names Recognized (0-26) by Year










Average Numbers and Operations Score (0-16) by Year and County












Average Numbers and Operations Score (0-16) by School and District




Percent of Kindergarteners Chronically Absent by County and Year








Percent of Kindergarteners Chronically Absent by School and District











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Percent of 3rd Graders Math Proficient by County and Year





Percent of 3rd Graders Math Proficient by School and District







Percent of 3rd Graders ELA Proficient by County and Year













Percent of 3rd Graders ELA Proficient by School and District








KA Math and 3rd Grade Math Comparison - EL Hub Region




Comparison of KA English Letter Sound Recognition and 3rd Grade ELA Proficiency, by School and District



KA Letter Sounds and 3rd Grade ELA Comparison - EL Hub Region








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
Comparison of KA English Letter Sound Recognition and 3rd Grade ELA Proficiency, by School and District


