
Pollywog Update May 2022






Successes: The Pollywog Program



- Pollywog has added 16 new partner agencies in Lincoln County, including both hospitals, the Health Department, DHS, a pediatric medical clinic, the relief nursery, and WIC. We are "in process" with many more
- Pollywog is registering families for prenatal classes taught remotely at Samaritan Pacific Communities
 Hospital in Newport, and soon we will be registering families for in-person classes at Samaritan North
 Lincoln Hospital in Lincoln City
- We currently have four members of our staff who are certified Traditional Health Workers, and we are waiting on a contract with the IHN-CCO to utilize them and further stabilize our funding
- Through a collaboration with Preschool Promise partners, there is currently a Pollywog digital billboard on Highway 34, heading west to Corvallis. Approximately 35,000 cars/day will see this billboard for one year
- We had a record number of referrals in April: 79 Self-Referrals, and 43 Partner Referrals






Challenges: The Pollywog Program



- We are seeing a decrease in the number of prenatal and childbirth classes being taught in our region by the hospital system:
 - Two hospitals have stopped classes entirely
 - There are no in-person classes being taught—everything is still remote
 - There are no Spanish-speaking prenatal classes available (through the hospitals)
 - Benton County raised their class fees to \$90
- It has been really difficult to build relationships in Lincoln County due to:
 - Wildfires
 - COVID outbreaks
 - Furloughs and mandatory closures
- We had a record number of referrals in April: 79 Self-Referrals, and 43 Partner Referrals






Next Steps: The Pollywog Program




- Continue to build database with community partners with a goal of 3 new partners each quarter

- Continue working to stabilize our funding


