Health, Safety and Nutrition (HSN) Class Options

Certified family and certified center staff are required to complete at least one hour of HSN training before the facility's license renewal.

- Registered family and substitutes are required to complete at least one hour of HSN in the first year of their license <u>and</u> at least one hour in the second year of their license.
- License-exempt DHS providers are required to complete at least one hour of HSN in the first year of their DHS listing <u>and</u> at least one hour in the second year of their listing.
